

- Infection Control Coordinator

#### How often does the committee meet?

Quarterly

#### What does the committee do?

- Monitor Quality Improvement Indicators (Falls, Pressure Ulcers, Avoidable Emergency Department visits, Restraints, Depression, Pain, Use of Antipsychotic medication).
- Review trends from abuse and complaints.
- Review Ethical issues that arise in the homes.
- Maintain Accreditation standards.
- Review Ministry of Long-Term Care Inspections.
- Look at current issues in Long-Term care.
- Share learnings.

#### Why do the two homes meet?


Hastings Centennial Manor and Hastings Manor are owned and operated by the County of Hastings. The homes have a mandate to work together in providing resident centered care.


