Celebration of Life

The Celebration of Life program was initiated in November 2019 from the gift of the "Celebration of Life Quilt" that was donated by the North Hastings Quilt Club.

The Celebration of Life is an opportunity for the residents to have their final wishes met; it provides closure for the co-residents who become friends; gives the team members the opportunity to "say goodbye" and it provides comfort for the care partners and families.



GOALS OF CARE

The Celebration of Life process begins with discussing residents Goals of Care which encompasses the residents wishes, wants, and needs at End of Life. The conversation includes care partners and families.

COMFORT CARE STAY

Being a rural home, many care partners and families live outside of the area. It is important for care partners/families to be near their loved one at end of life. To accommodate this need, we offer a Family Suite that offers comfortable living space while they are here. The unit includes, seating, dinette, microwave, mini fridge, telephone, bedroom and 4-piece bath.







COMFORT CARE CART

In May, the Committee was able to initiate the Comfort Care Cart. The Comfort Care Cart supports the need for comfort care for care partners/families during the End-of-Life experience. The Cart provides the necessities the care partners/families will need so they can spend more time with their loved one.
